Zbigniew J. Traczyk, from Warsaw, Poland, has been a Project Management Professional (PMP)[®] credential holder since 2001 and an active PMI member since 2002. Over the course of his 20-year career, Mr. Traczyk has managed several international projects in the financial, telecommunication and public sectors. He currently manages a portfolio of IT projects for IBM, leading regional integrated technology services delivery in 15 countries.

Mr. Traczyk was a founder of the PMI Warsaw Poland Chapter and served as chapter president from 2003–2006, leading the chapter to earn awards for “Chapter of the Year” and “Collaboration.” He contributed to the PMI Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct as a member of the PMI Ethics Standard Development Team and served

four years as a PMI Mentor in the EMEA region. His leadership also played a significant role in the development of PMI’s strategic alignment scorecard with the concept of core and extended services.

In addition to his other contributions, Mr. Traczyk provided leadership on the PMI Community Transformation Project in 2005–2006 as a steering committee member and contributed to the chapter-with-branches model, leading the first pilot implementation. He has supported the PMI Research Conference, numerous PMI Leadership Institute meetings and organized several Region 8 Meetings. He is currently a member of the PMI South Florida Chapter, PMI New York City Chapter and PMI Poland Chapter and will serve on the 2012 Performance Oversight Committee.
